It is already fall and we are nearly a month into virtual learning and as each day passes, we will continue to grow and get better at virtual teaching and learning. Over the past week or so, there has been a lot of dialogue on social media about when we will return to school and the negatives of on-line learning. As we are working diligently to provide a safe and welcoming on-line experience, I encourage you to not forget the positive things that are occurring as well. This is always a great opportunity to build community, and foster new relationships in a safe and inclusive environment.

This library was a special project that was spearheaded by a group of compassionate Judah parents and donated funds.
