

New COVID-19 Take Home Testing Kits: InteliSwab

Please note: This test takes 30 minutes to complete.

- AT HOME TESTING KITS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED DECEMBER 21st -23rd.
- Keep the test stand for all tests in the box. You will need to use it for the second test.
- Use the easy to follow pictures and instructions inside the box on how to do the test.
- When used for children, the test should be performed by an adult.
- For those 14 years and below: slowly circle the swab in EACH nostril at least 4 times while gently pressing against the inside of the nostril. This should take about 15 seconds.
- For those above the age of 15: Swab each nostril, circling at least 15 times.



Toni Smith, Health Aide


- Toni manages our Care Room, supporting students' health and wellness

TJE's new spirit wear site is up and running!




Our new vendor is First Place Spirit Wear.
